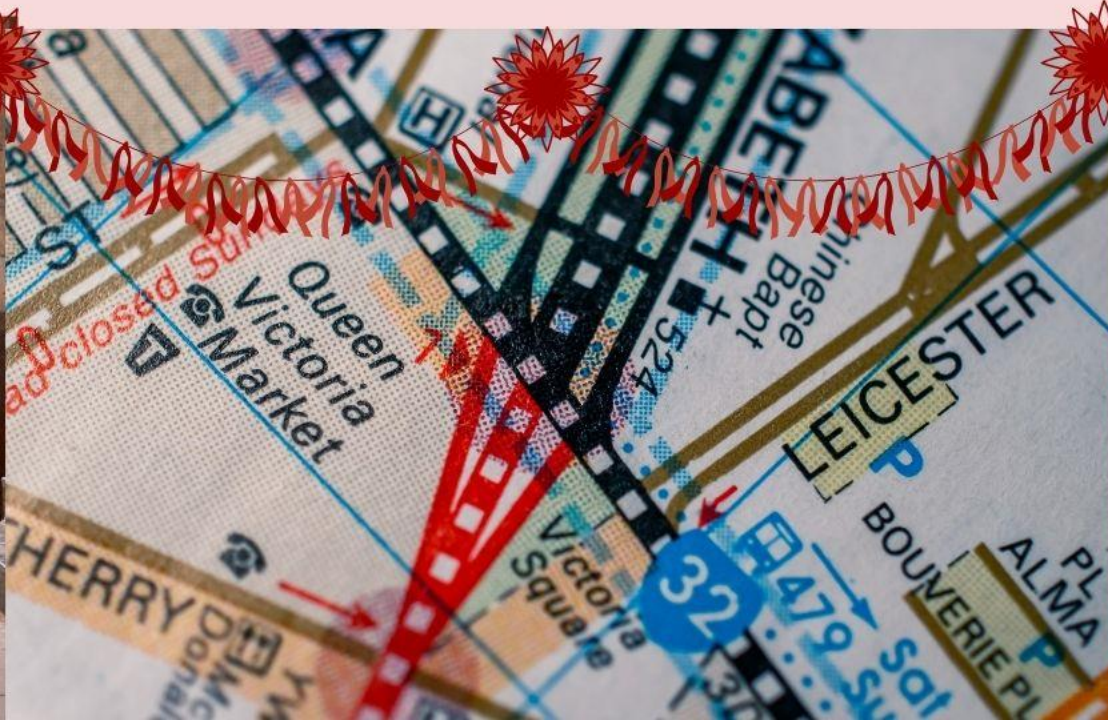

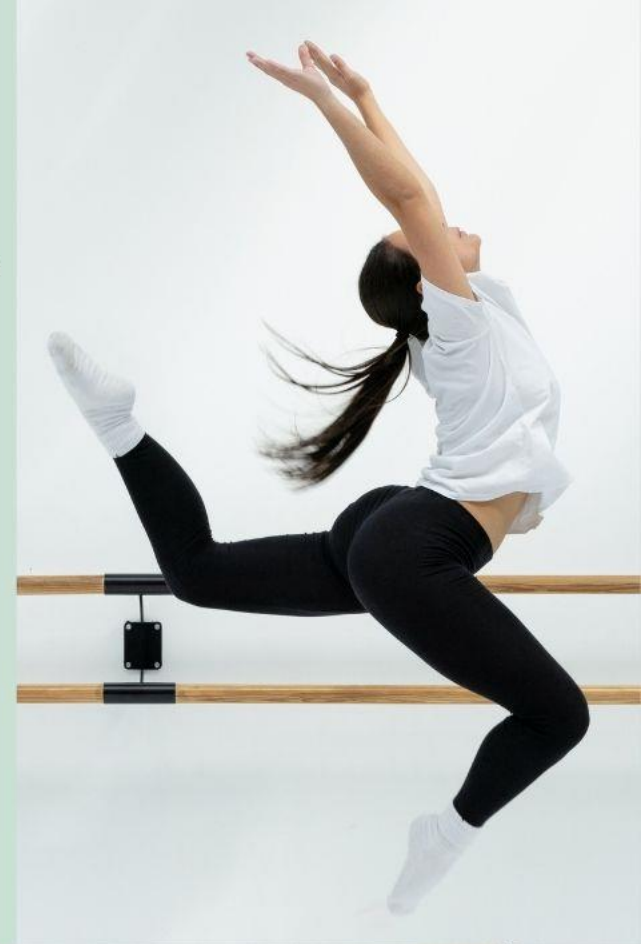


WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

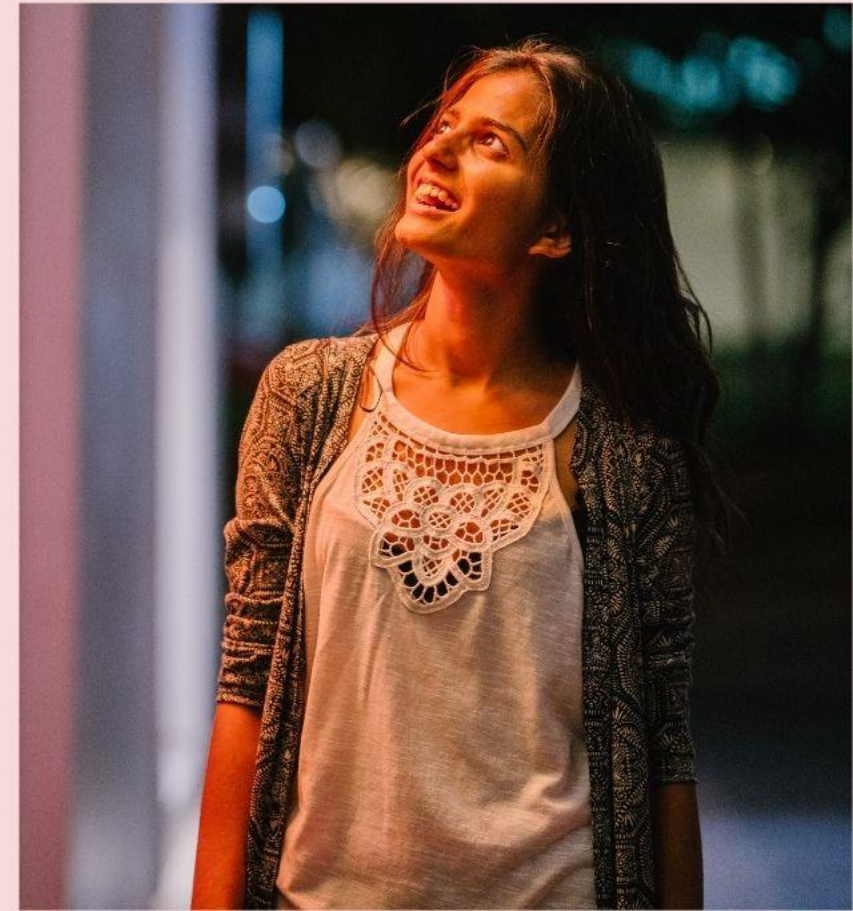
